

Notice Regarding the Use of the API Service

When using the API (Application Programming Interface) provided by the "Bank of Japan Time-Series Data Search" (hereinafter referred to as the "API"), please follow the instructions below.

The Bank of Japan may revise the instructions without prior notice to users.

I. Notification on the Release of Services using the API

If a user releases a service which uses the API, please notify the Research and Statistics Department of the Bank of Japan about the service release via email, using the subject line provided below. We may contact you at a later date as needed.

II. Credit

In releasing any service which uses the API, please clearly acknowledge the use of the API. Specifically, we kindly request the use of the following credit.

"This service uses the API provided by the "Bank of Japan Time-Series Data Search."

The Bank of Japan does not guarantee the content of the service."

There is no specific requirement for the display location as long as it can be easily referenced by users of the service.

III. Condition of the API Service Provision

1. The API may be suspended or its performance may deteriorate without notice.
2. The Bank reserves the right to suspend the API and change its specifications without prior notice.
3. The Bank may limit access depending on the load status of the API.

IV. Prohibitions

1. Users shall not engage in any of following acts.
 - Act of interference with regards to the operation of the API
 - Excessive access frequency or other acts that interfere with the operation of the API
2. The Bank reserves the right to suspend the API to users if the Bank determines users are committing or are likely to commit any of the above-mentioned acts.

1. The Bank shall not be held liable to users or any third parties for any damages or losses that may arise from the suspension, performance deterioration, or other issues related to the API.
